Dear Mr. Harris:

By way of this letter, Respondent, Tyrell Davis, hereby requests a sixty (60) day extension of time in which to file its brief in opposition to petition for writ of certiorari. Respondent's current due date is April 19, 2024, making the new due date June 18, 2024.

The extension is necessary because I have had insufficient time to review, research and draft an appropriate response due to deadlines in other cases. Specifically, since Petitioner's Petition for Certiorari was filed on March 8, 2024, I have completed drafting and filed an answering brief before the Idaho Supreme Court in Row v. State, an appeal from the denial of post-conviction relief in a capital case; and an answer and motion for summary dismissal in Dunlap v. State, a capital case involving the filing of a successive post-conviction petition. I have also been preparing an answer in Abdullah v. Richardson, a capital federal habeas case involving 74 claims, with multiple sub-claims, that is currently due May 7, 2024. Finally, I took my first extended vacation in five years that had been planned since July 2023.

I contacted James Ball, counsel for Petitioner, who stated he has no objection to Respondent's request for additional time to file its brief in opposition to petition for writ of certiorari.
