ORDER:

Billy Joe King, Texas prisoner # 02280417, moves for a certificate of appealability (COA) to appeal the district court's denial of his 28 U.S.C. § 2254 application challenging his conviction of two counts of continuous sexual abuse of a child. He renews his argument that his trial counsel was ineffective for failing to investigate his intellectual deficiency. King does not challenge the district court's denial of his claim that his counsel was ineffective for failing to object at trial to a witness's non-responsive statement. Therefore, he has abandoned any challenge to this determination

by the district court. *See Yohey v. Collins*, 985 F.2d 222, 224-25 (5th Cir. 1993); *Brinkmann v. Dallas Cnty. Deputy Sheriff Abner*, 813 F.2d 744, 748 (5th Cir. 1987).

To obtain a COA, King must show that “reasonable jurists would find the district court’s assessment of the constitutional claim[] debatable or wrong.” *Slack v. McDaniel*, 529 U.S. 473, 484 (2000); *see* 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2). He has not made the required showing. Accordingly, his motion for a COA is DENIED.


FINAL JUDGMENT
