Mr. Quinn, files this Pro-se Petition for Rehearing of this court's denial of his "Writ of Certiorari", filed within this case.

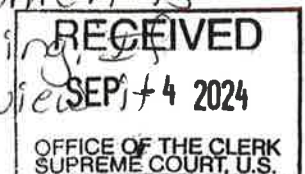
