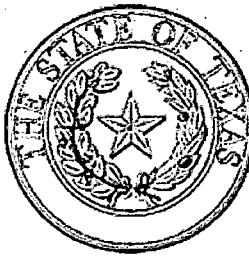

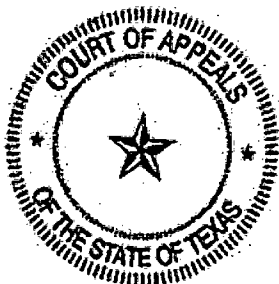
Before our Court of Appeals on May 11, 2023, the cause upon appeal to revise or reverse your judgment was determined. Our Court of Appeals made its order in these words:
