This appeal is from the denial of appellant's Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b) motion. The request for a certificate of appealability (Docket Entry No. 4) is denied because appellant has not shown that "jurists of reason would find it debatable whether the petition states a valid claim of the denial of a constitutional right and that jurists of reason would find it debatable whether the district court was correct in its procedural ruling." *Slack v. McDaniel*, 529 U.S. 473, 484 (2000); *see also* 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2); *Gonzalez v. Thaler*, 565 U.S. 134, 140-41 (2012); *Gonzalez v. Crosby*, 545 U.S. 524, 530-31 (2005); *United States v. Winkles*, 795 F.3d 1134, 1143 (9th Cir. 2015); *Ortiz v. Stewart*, 195 F.3d 520, 520-21 (9th Cir. 1999); *Lynch v. Blodgett*, 999 F.2d 401, 403 (9th Cir. 1993) (order).
