Dear Mr. Harris and Mr. Warrington:

I represent a nominal Respondent—Colorado Republican State Central Committee in the above-captioned case—as counsel of record. Respondent has separately filed a petition for certiorari seeking this Court's review of the same underlying decision. *See Colorado Republican State Central Committee v. Norma Anderson, et al.*, U.S. No. 23-696. Respondent does not intend to file a response to Petitioner Donald J. Trump's Certiorari Petition.

Respondent agrees with and adopts the legal issues and analysis raised by President Trump's Certiorari Petition, in addition to the reasons advanced in its own petition, for overturning the judgment below of the Colorado Supreme Court. Without waiving any other arguments, Respondent particularly agrees and adopts President Trump's argument that the Constitution's text commits the question of disqualification to Congress, not individual states, *see* Trump Pet. at 19-23, and his argument that Section Three does not permit the exclusion of President Trump from the electoral ballot. *See id.* at 31-34.
