O R D E R

---

Daquan Doral Carter seeks to appeal his sentence. The Government has moved to dismiss the appeal as barred by Carter's waiver of the right to appeal included in the plea agreement. Upon review of the record, we conclude that Carter knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to appeal and that the issues Carter seeks to raise on appeal fall squarely within the scope of the waiver. Accordingly, we grant the Government's motion to dismiss.
