**To the honorable justices of this court, I Gary Maddox jr was released on November 17, 2023 after completing the maximum expiration date of the sentence and parole sentence of this case. upon my release I was driven to Baltimore city central booking facility, which is normal, except that upon arrival I was placed in to a holding cell where a male officer came and handed me a letter Att. 1 and explain to me that if I did not sign all documents pertaining to this letter that he would be forced to call the Baltimore city police department and have me rebooked for failure to comply with the sex offenders registry and that I would not be released. I refused and explained that I did not have these kind of charges or a duty to register and then he stated that I had a choice to make and that I had up until 11:59 pm which is the time that the central booking stops releasing people. And that after that, he would call the police and have me rebooked and sent back upstairs. After**

**30 minutes I signed the papers under the threat of being recharged and placed back in jail. I explained to him that I would be reporting this to the courts because there is a case pertaining to this type of situation he then said it didn't have anything to do with him, and that this wasn't coming from him it was coming from the higher-up's and then I was released. I am reporting this to this court because it is a last minute attempt to cause an irreparable harm at the very end of my sentence. in the two recordings from the impartial tribunal, hearings that have been entered into this case and the recording of David R Blumberg and myself the parole commission has repeatedly stated for the record that Mr Maddox does not have a duty to register as a sex offender and also that both times the parole commission issued warrants for Maddox's arrest and released Maddox They never at no time attempted to force Mr Maddox into registering as a sex offender. only at the maximum release date of this jail sentence and parole sentence. Did they do this which is an attempt at having Maddox arrested on a warrant if he does not comply with this letters request which has stopped Maddox from even going home for the holidays this is wrong and cruel and unusual punishment. I respectfully request that this court, please order the parole commission and their attorney Susan Barron howe to contact these authorities see Att. 1 and reverse what the parole commission is trying to do so that a warrant is not issued for Maddox's arrest placing him back in jail for not registering as a sex offender which they**

**clearly understand that Maddox does not have a duty to do. this is also a direct reflection of the purpose for the falsified documents that have been entered in this case. I ask that the justices of this court, please consider that Maddox would have never filed anymore writings in this case, if the situation was not detrimental to his life and liberty**

**AFFIDAVIT OF DAVID R. BLUMBERG**

I, David R. Blumberg, am over eighteen years of age and am competent to testify.

1. I have been the Chairman of the Maryland Parole Commission since July 1, 2004. I served as a commissioner of the Maryland Parole Commission from October 1, 2003 until my appointment as Chairman.

2. As the Chairman of the Maryland Parole Commission, I am a custodian of the files and records of the Commission, and I am familiar with the policies and procedures of the Parole Commission. I am also familiar with the policies of the Division of Parole and Probation, as they relate to the supervision of individuals on parole and mandatory supervision release.

3. I certify that the attached documents pertaining to Gary E. Maddox, Jr., are true and accurate copies of records kept in the ordinary course of business of the Maryland Parole Commission.

4. The Division of Parole and Probation's Collaborative Offender Management Enforcement Treatment ("COMET") program is an intensive supervision program for sex

offenders. COMET can include heightened reporting requirements, electronic monitoring, polygraph testing, and specialized treatment.

5. In 2014, Mr. Maddox was convicted in the Circuit Court for Howard County of human trafficking for financial benefit, for which he received a 10-year sentence. He was mandatorily released from the Division of Correction on September 24, 2019. Although the Commission has not revoked his release, Mr. Maddox has had supervision failures, including: failing to provide a urine sample for testing; leaving the State of Maryland without his agent's permission to travel to the District of Columbia, northern Virginia, and Pennsylvania; and failing to comply with the requirements of the COMET program.

6. The Parole Commission considers human trafficking for financial benefit to be a sex offense because the crime involves the sexual subjugation of another person for financial benefit.

7. The Commission has determined that the Division of Parole and Probation has correctly placed Mr. Maddox in its COMET program, given the nature of his offense as well as his supervision violations -- most notably, leaving the State without his agent's permission on multiple occasions.

I solemnly affirm under the penalties of perjury and upon personal knowledge that the contents of the foregoing affidavit are true.

To whom it may concern,

Mr. Gary Maddox Jr, was referred to HBH Wellness, LLC due to his past arrest history. The purpose of this referral was to see if he met the requirements to be a member of our sexual offender therapy program . Mr. Maddox arrived at the office very apprehensive and non-compliant. He made sure to let us know that he was only here because he is being forced by the State of Maryland. Mr. Maddox completed a two session evaluation which included the Columbia-Suicide Severity Rating Scale (C-SSRS), Depression Anxiety Stress Scale-21 (DASS-21), anxiety assessment, and a comprehensive psychosexual evaluation. He was asked about his family history, educational background, any mental health concerns, and intimate relationship history.

In conclusion of the assessment for Mr. Maddox, this writer has determined that he does not meet the criteria to be classified as a sex offender and therefore, he does not meet the requirement to participate in sexual offender program. He does not display any tendencies to hurt, harm, or attack anyone of the opposite sex or same gender.

I Garry Maddox, am writing this letter to the Special Court of Appeals, the Parole Commissioner of Maryland, and the Circuit Court of Baltimore informing you all that my right to appeal an impartial Tribunal/Parole hearing has been violated by the Parole Commission. On November 2, 2021 the Parole Commission subpoena me before a parole hearing was held by commissioner Miller. I was ordered to undergo sex-offender assessment. I appealed this decision with a request for a judicial review and a stop agency order; both were entered into the Circuit Court on November 8, 2021. On November 22, 2021 Judge Marilyn Bentley ordered the Parole Commission to respond within 30 days of receiving the order.

The Parole Commission responded to the Judicial Review on December 27, 2021 asking for a dismissal of the Judicial Review and never responding at all to the Stop Agency Order. Chief Judge Marilyn Bentley ordered the Commission to respond to both entries.

On January 18, 2022 I was arrested and the appeal had not been deliberated nor did they ever responded to the Stop Agency Order.

The Judicial Review was dismissed on January 24, 2022 after my arrest and still the Stop Agency Order was never responded to.

The Parole Commission has violated my right to appeal my Parole Hearing/Impartial Tribunal. This is a direct violation of the appeals process and also a Judicial Review was supposed to be reviewed by the Administrative Law Judge. Brian E. Frofh has managed to have it reviewed by Judge Nugent the same judge who reviewed and dismissed my

complaint# 24-C-21 – 0 0 3 0 8 6. This is starting to seem like more corruption and now I am in jail illegally for appealing a parole decision. Every time I stand up for my rights I am being punished and thrown in jail illegally which is very unfair. This is literally punishment without due process. Please help, my mail is being held at Jessup Correctional Institution (JCI) which is why I have to send letters to you from an outside entity; my mother. I can't place money in my account because there was also a hold on that According to the DOC when my family called here from Rhode Island.

Please check case history for everything I said here at case #24-C-21-00-4939  
I filed several motions from JCI on January 20, 2022 that never made it to either the Circuit Court or the Special Appeals Court.
