**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, THADDEUS RHODES, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. A judge of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia determined Mr. Rhodes to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Mr. Rhodes in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

2. Mr. Rhodes was incarcerated in this federal case between his arrest on February 21, 2019, until his release from prison on May 26, 2020, he was released on an unsecured bond. On November 7, 2022, following his conviction, Mr. Rhodes was remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal Service, he remains indigent. Through counsel, he will file in this Court a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* and wishes to do so *in forma pauperis*.

WHEREFORE Mr. Rhodes asks this Court to grant this motion to allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
