ORDER AFFIRMING DENIAL OF POST-CONVICTION RELIEF

Petitioner, pro se, appeals the denial of post-conviction relief by the District Court of Oklahoma County in Case No. CF-2010-2243. Petitioner filed an application for post-conviction relief in the District Court on December 11, 2023. In a through order filed on April 18, 2024, the Honorable Susan Stallings, District Judge, denied post-conviction relief, specifically finding the application was time barred by 22 O.S.Supp.2022, § 1080.1. We agree.

Effective November 1, 2022, a one-year time limitation for filing post-conviction applications was established. 22 O.S.Supp.2022, § 1080.1. "Accordingly, petitioners whose convictions became final on or before November 1, 2022, had until November 1, 2023, to file their application for post-conviction relief." *Hammon v. State*, 2023 OK CR 19, ¶ 12, 540 P.3d 486, 489. Petitioner's conviction was final before


November 1, 2022, his application for post-conviction relief was filed after November 1, 2023, and no exceptions apply. 22 O.S.Supp.2022, § 1080.1.

Petitioner has failed to demonstrate an abuse of discretion by the District Court. Therefore, the District Court's order denying post-conviction relief is **AFFIRMED**. Pursuant to Rule 3.15, *Rules of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals*, Title 22, Ch.18, App. (2024), the **MANDATE** is **ORDERED** issued upon the delivery and filing of this decision.


