I write to apprise you of an inadvertent omission from my Petition for Certiorari, filed on February 26, 2024. My Petition raises both Due Process and Equal Protection arguments. I want to assure the Court that these arguments were adequately presented to the state courts below, and so should be deemed preserved for review by this Court.


The Petition makes references to where I raised the Equal Protection arguments below in the state courts. Pet. 6, citing App.35-45, App.46-57. Notably, these references (App.35-45; App.46-57) also include my Due Process arguments raised below in the state courts. App.40-45; App.46-47, 49, 50, 55-57 (discussing due process).

Thus, even though the Petition does not explicitly assert that the Due Process arguments were raised below, the Due Process arguments were indeed raised below. I inadvertently forgot to mention in my Petition that the Due Process arguments were raised below in the state courts.

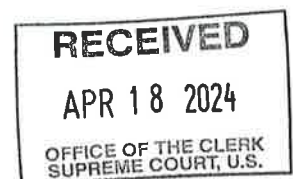
Accordingly, I would like the Court to be aware that my Due Process arguments were raised below in the state courts, and so, in the furtherance of justice, they should be deemed preserved for review in this Court. Therefore, if the Court finds my Questions Presented worthy of consideration, I would like the Court to be assured that these issues were adequately raised in the state courts.
