To the Honorable Elena Kagan, as Circuit Justice for the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit:

Pursuant to this Court's Rules 13.5, 22, 30.2, and 30.3, Petitioner pro se, Stephen Ireland, M.D., respectfully requests that the time to file its Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this matter be extended for 60 days up to and including December 18, 2023.
