

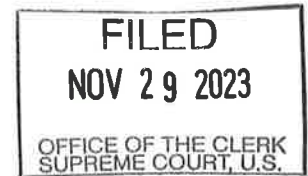

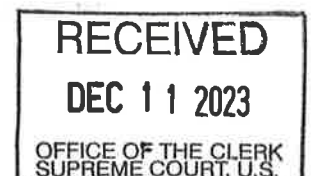
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Petitioner Randall E. Cope, **Pro Se**, Moves this Honorable Court for an Extension of Time of An Additional 90 Days to File His Petition for Writ of Certiorari. In support, Petitioner Cope states:

The United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit denied his Request for Rehearing/Suggestion for Rehearing En Banc on September 13, 2023. 2023 U.S. App. LEXIS 24454.

Cope has been compiling his petition to this Honorable Court, but the Bureau of Prisons informed him yesterday that he is being immediately transferred to another facility. As a result of this, Cope cannot complete his petition on time and needs another 90 days to ensure his legal work catches up with him.
