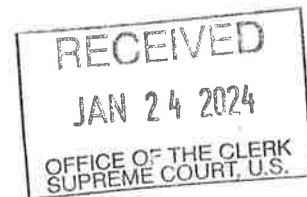
Comes Now Plaintiff Subari J. Johnson requests an extension of 60 days to file my writ of certiorari regarding case 23-CV-02454-LTB
