MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE
of petition for writ of certiorari

Comes now, TO THE HONORABLE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME COURT, Bruce Wayne Harp, 01929800, as petitioner, and files this Motion for Continuance of this cause from its present setting of November 20, 2023 and shows the following:


1. Petitioner is proceeding pro se.
2. Date received notice from retained attorney Steven J Lieberman of the 5th Circuit's August 23, 2023 denial of Certificate of Appealability (COA), case: 23-40110, was September 22, 2023. Lieberman's cover letter was dated Friday, August 24, 2023.
3. Petitioner has lingering symptoms of long COVID from November 8, 2021 COVID booster shot. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice nor its medical providers, Texas Tech and University of Texas Medical Branch, recognize or monitor long

Petitioner was told Clements does not carry the forms and to ask the Supreme Court for them, but no address was given. My son, Christopher Harp, could not find a request for forms on www.supremecourt.gov.
5. Petitioner's daughter, Sarah Woolery, contacted petitioner's previous attorney, Steven J Lieberman, requesting him to send forms to petition the Supreme Court for writ of certiorari. She could not mail them to petitioner due to the digital mail system that began July 17, 2023. Lieberman replied to Sarah's email of September 27, 2023 claiming to have mailed them immediately. As of the date of this Motion petitioner has not received any forms to petition for writ of certiorari.
6. PLEASE MAIL PETITIONER THREE (3) FORMS TO PETITION THE SUPREME COURT FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI.
7. This motion is not made for purposes of

delay, but that justice may be served.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner pro se prays the Court to enter its Order continuing this cause until January 4, 2024 or enter a stay until enclosed Motion in Limine is granted and executed by the Court, or denied.
