PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR A

WRIT OF CERTIORARI, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30(2)-(3).

Comes now Petitioner CARMEN DIFILIPPANTONIO, in propria persona and forma pauperis, and respectfully petitions the Honorable Justice Elena Kagan to permit him an extension of time to properly and completely research, prepare and file a compliant Petition For a Writ of Certiorari by May 31, 2024.

The Arizona Supreme Court denied Petitioner's Petition For Review in his state direct appeal from his jury trial criminal case on March 5, 2024. The Mandate of Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, has not yet issued. See, Attachment 1.

Petitioner intends to present the issues raised in the state courts to the United States Supreme Court, which should prove compelling reasons for its granting of a writ of certiorari. These include that a state court of last resort has decided important questions in a way that conflicts with the decisions of another state court(s) of last resort or of a United States court of appeals, and that a state court has decided important questions of federal law that has not been, but should be, settled by this Court, or has decided important federal questions in a way that conflict with relevant decisions of this Court.

The extra time is needed because of the many impediments to progress endemic to incarceration, such as frequent and unpredictable closures of the already limited access law library, lock-downs, and other daily interruptions.

Furthermore, Petitioner has no attorney, is far from a legal scholar, and needs the time to properly and adequately study and comprehend the relevant laws and procedures so as to reasonably and sensibly articulate his claims.
