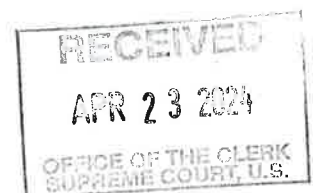

Also on March 12, 2024, I had cataract eye surgery on my left eye and I have another surgery scheduled on May 1, 2024 for my right eye.
