PLEASE GRANT ME A 60 DAY EXTENSION FROM THE JUNE 24TH 2024

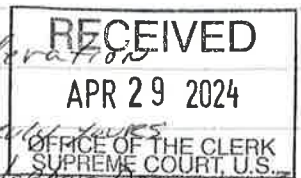
