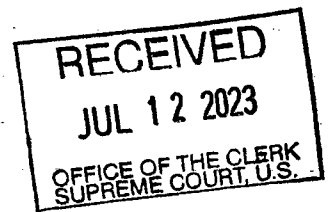

RE: Request to file petition for writ of certiorari out of time
Behroozi v. Chief Judge Jeremiah et.al.
USCA1 No. 21-1744

Dear Mr. Harris;

I am a pro se petitioner for this case. I filed my petition for a writ of certiorari on March 21, 2023 in accordance with Rule 29.2 "sent to the clerk through the United States postal service by first class mail (priority) postage prepaid, and bears postmark other than a commercial postage meter label, showing that the document was mailed on the last day for filing."

Your letter dated June 26, 2023 states according to Rule 13.1 [90 days] my petition was due on or before June 18, 2023.

The last day for June 18, 2023 is a Sunday; a day in which this court is not open for business; thereby making the petition due by June 19, 2023.

June 19, 2023 is a federal holiday thereby making the petition due by June 20, 2023.

Extraordinary Circumstance [Rule 30.2]

The United States Court of Appeals for the first Circuit's judgment denying review entered on March 20, 2023.

1) Petitioner filed her writ of certiorari relying on Rule 30.1 "the day of the act from which the designated period begins to run is not included." Thereby excluding the 20th as the last day instead the 21st being the last day to file.

2) This is petitioner's first request to file out of time. Good cause exist for the requested action.

- 3) The petitioner's disabling condition limits her effectiveness in writing the necessary court filings.
- 4) The petitioner has an on going property interest going back to 2006 in accordance with the 2006 judgment which has never been executed. To deny the one day out of time filing for the writ of certiorari would effect an gross miscarriage of justice.
- 5) In familiarizing myself with relevant legal issues, laws, and the record, I devoted substantial amounts of time through irrelevant legal standards; to obtain appropriate information.
- 6) The matters for this cause for action gives rise to conflict between the Rhode Island court of last resort and the RI family court of enforcement.
- 7) The matters for this cause for action gives rise to conflict between two federal district courts of IDAHO and Rhode Island.
- 8) The matters for this cause for action gives rise to conflict between the United States Court of Appeals and the court of last resort in Rhode Island.

Accordingly petitioner respectfully request that out of time filing by one day March 21, 2023 be granted.
