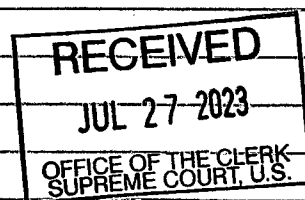

Comes now, Petitioner, Earnest D. Bolton, pro se requests this Court to file his Petition for writ of Certiorari out of time based on the following:

On December 3, 2021 I received notice that my Petition for writ of Habeas Corpus had been denied by the U.S. District Court, Jacksonville Division.

On December 6, 2021 I filed a notice of appeal on the denial of the petition, Case number 3:19-cv-00041-HLA-LLL. I never received a response, nor did I receive the above 11th Circuit Case number. It was only after multiple inquiries between February and July 2022 did I receive notice that the appeal had been dismissed for failure to pay filing and docketing fees or alternatively file a motion to proceed in forma pauperis.

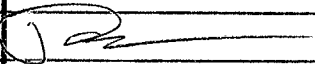


Again, I never received the above case number and as a result I was denied the opportunity to proceed any further because I had no case number to do such.

A Petition for Writ of Certiorari was filed on May 10, 2023 with this Court.

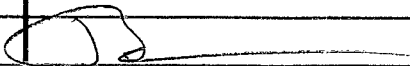
I respectfully request that this honorable Court file this petition out of time.
