**PETITIONER'S MOTION REQUESTING LEAVE TO FILE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI, INSTANTER**

INTRODUCTION

COMES NOW the Self-Represented Petitioner, **ARTESIA CAMERON**, by and through her natural self, Artesia of the Cameron family, reserving all rights and waving none, ever, and submits this Motion Requesting Leave To File Petition for Writ of Certiorari, instanter, seeking of this court to grant this motion and allow the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to be filed eight (8) days out of time.
