Dear Mr. Harris:

We represent Respondent Harman International Industries, Inc. (“Respondent”) in the above-captioned case. Petitioner Jem Accessories, Inc. D/B/A Xtreme Cables (“Petitioner”) filed its Petition for Writ of Certiorari on March 19, 2025 and the Court docketed the petition on March 21, 2025, making Respondent’s deadline to oppose the Petition April 21, 2025. *See* Court Rule 15(3). Pursuant to Court Rule 30(4), Respondent respectfully requests a 21-day extension of time to file its brief in opposition.

The extension of time is justified in light of Respondent’s counsel’s professional and personal obligations between now and the current due date. These professional obligations include deadlines in various federal court proceedings including the cases captioned *Legacy Advancement v. Vertex Education LLC et al*, No. 6:24-cv-04047-JDA (D.S.C.), *Autec Power, Inc. et al v. Vencient Barnes et al*, No. 2:23-cv-09273-MRA-JPR (C.D. Cal.), and *Signum, LLC et al v. Indianapolis Organic Lawn Care, Inc. et al*, No. 1:24-cv-00541-SEB-MJD (S.D. Ind.), among others, as well as other non-court related prior obligations. Additionally, I will be out of office on a pre-planned family vacation the same week Respondent’s brief in opposition is currently due.

The requested extension is necessary to ensure Respondent and its counsel have adequate opportunity to review and respond to the petition in a manner most helpful to the Court. There are no circumstances requiring a speedy ruling on the Petition. Indeed, I have conferred with counsel for Petitioner and they advised that Petitioner does not oppose this request. Accordingly, Respondent requests a 21-day extension of time to and including May 12, 2025, to file its brief in opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
