Declaration of Timely Filing

Re: *California Association for the Preservation of Gamefowl Petition*

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct. I work for the printing company Supreme Court Press. On June 5, 2025, the company printed a petition for the *California Association for the Preservation of Gamefowl*. A full set of books was printed and bound and ready to ship. However, a critical error was detected on the appendices, which did not list the proper case caption information on two opinions/orders. This was a client prepped document (print-ready file where client is responsible for all content and formatting), and we had repeatedly stressed the importance of accuracy in dates and case numbers on appendix items, but the error was still present on the final client print file. On that day June 5, 2025, I deposited one copy by U.S.P.S. first class mail at the Boston main post office which is open and intakes through midnight, with a note stating that corrected versions were to be mailed within one week. Instead of a full reprint, the client opted for a correction sticker which was implemented and then mailed with all 40 booklets on June 10, 2025.
