Dear Mr. Harris:

I am writing to request the Court's permission to defer submission of the joint appendix under Rule 26.4 in the above-captioned case. As contemplated under Rule 26.4, the parties would file the joint appendix on or before October 29, 2025—within 14 days after the brief for the respondent has been filed. The parties have agreed to file their principal briefs with reference to pages of the record in accordance with the current briefing schedule, and to file copies of the briefs in compliance with rule 33.1 containing references to pages of the joint appendix in place of record citations on or before November 10, 2025—the next business day within 10 days after the joint appendix is filed. Counsel for respondents has indicated that respondents support this request.

The parties believe that deferring submission of the joint appendix will aid the Court's consideration of this case. The record here is voluminous, spanning half a dozen years of litigation and a lengthy jury trial with many witnesses and exhibits. Deferring the appendix will give the parties time to better identify, and limit the joint appendix to, those materials most helpful to the Court's consideration of the issues in dispute.
