Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am counsel for Respondents in the above-referenced case. On September 20, 2024, a certiorari petition was docketed in this case. On October 11, 2024, the Court granted Respondents' motion to extend the time to file a response to and including November 25, 2024.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an additional extension of 30 days, which, due to the Christmas holiday, would result in a new deadline of December 26, 2024. The parties in this and related matters are engaged in settlement discussions, and are optimistic an amicable resolution may be reached without further litigation.
