The Petitioners in the above-entitled case filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari on October 16, 2024 for review of the judgment issued in *Walton v. Neskowin Regional Sanitary Authority*, 372 Or. 331 (2024). The petition was placed on the docket on October 30, 2024. Under the Court's rules, Respondent Neskowin Regional Sanitary Authority's Brief in Opposition is presently due on November 29, 2024.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests an extension of time of 30 days to file its Brief in Opposition in this Court up to and including December 29, 2024. This application for an extension of time is filed within the period sought to be extended. This is Respondent's first request for an extension of time.

Respondent's counsel requires additional time to fully review the record and Petition, prepare a Brief in Opposition, and meet court filings in other cases. For instance, counsel has upcoming obligations in *U.S. Structural Plywood Integrity Coalition, et. al., v.
