If Petitioner feels she has been denied an appeal through no fault of her own, she may seek the appropriate relief with the District Court. See Rule 2.1(E)(1), *Rules of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals*, Title 22, Ch.18, App. (2024). Issuance of this order concludes proceedings before this Court.

The Court **DECLINES** jurisdiction and **DISMISSES** this matter.
