

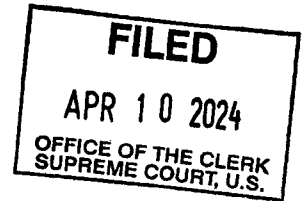


1. Walter K. Pyle is appointed to represent Juan Marquis Holiday in this case.
