Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari was filed on November 12, 2024, and placed on the docket on November 14, 2024. On January 7, 2025, the Court requested that respondent Nationstar Mortgage LLC file a response to the petition, which is currently due February 6, 2025.

Pursuant to this Court's Rule 30.4, Nationstar requests a 32-day extension, until March 10, 2025 (a Monday), within which to file its response to the petition for certiorari. This extension is justified by other professional commitments that make the preparation of a response by the existing deadline impractical. These commitments include an oral argument in the Federal Circuit on February 5, 2025, and briefs due in the Ninth Circuit and Federal Circuit on February 10 and February 13.

For the foregoing reasons, Nationstar respectfully requests that the time to file a response to the petition for a writ of certiorari be extended to and including March 10, 2025.
