Petitioner's request for post-conviction relief was denied by the District Court in an order filed September 26, 2023. Petitioner's Petition in Error should have been filed with this Court on or before November 27, 2023, but was not filed until November 29, 2023. Petitioner failed to timely file the Petition in Error with the Clerk of this Court within sixty (60) days from the filing date of the District Court's final order. See Rule 5.2(C)(2), *Rules of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals*, Title 22, Ch.18, App. (2024). The Court **DECLINES** jurisdiction and **DISMISSES** this matter. If Petitioner feels he has been denied a post-conviction appeal through no fault of his own, he may seek the appropriate relief with the District Court. See Rule 2.1(E)(1), *Rules of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals*, Title 22, Ch.18, App. (2024).
