COMES NOW, Defendant-Appellant moves for an Order:

Granting leave pursuant to Rule 37 of the Colorado Rules of Criminal Procedure to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis, without payment of filing fees and costs;

Ordering a free transcript in the within case; and

Appointing the Colorado State Public Defender’s Office as counsel to represent Defendant-Appellant in this appeal on the following grounds:

Troy Fields was accepted for Public Defender representation on or about March 18th, 2017. Initially, the Office of the Public Defender was appointed to represent Mr. Fields, however Mr. Fields elected to proceed pro se. On November 26th, 2018, Undersigned counsel was appointed as advisory counsel, and on April 19th, 2019, the Court found a conflict and appointed undersigned counsel as Alternate Defense Counsel. Mr. Fields is indigent and without funds with which to pay the filing fees and costs of an appeal; and with which to pay for a transcript of the proceedings and record on appeal; and with which to employ counsel on appeal. Mr. Fields is presently serving a Sentence of Life with the possibility of parole after 40 calendar years.
