MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner Terris Chanley Baker, by counsel, respectfully requests that he be permitted to proceed in this matter *in forma pauperis*. Mr. Baker offers the following in order to assist the Court:

At the initiation of proceedings in the district court, Mr. Baker was appointed counsel through the Criminal Justice Act based on his financial circumstances.
