**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, ERIC ROBERT RUDOLPH, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. Judges of both the United States District Court for the Northern District of Alabama and the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia determined Rudolph to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Rudolph in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

2. Rudolph has been incarcerated since his arrest on May 30, 2003, and remains indigent. Through counsel, he will file in this Court a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* and wishes to do so *in forma pauperis*.

WHEREFORE Rudolph asks this Court to grant this motion to allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
