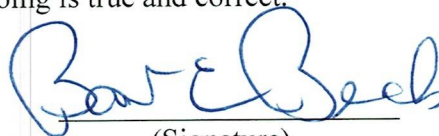
**AFFIDAVIT OR DECLARATION
