Dear Mr. Harris,

I represent the Petitioners in this case, which the Court granted certiorari on June 2, 2025. Under Rule 25, Petitioners' opening brief is due on July 17, 2025, and Respondents' brief is due on August 16, 2025. Counsel for both parties are discussing possible briefing schedules. The Court has not yet scheduled oral arguments.

Counsel for Petitioners and Respondents desire extensions for their respective opening briefs. To that end, Petitioners and Respondents jointly propose the following schedule: The time in which to file Petitioners' brief would be extended to and including July 31, 2025, and the time in which to file Respondents' brief would be extend to and including September 12, 2025. Under Rule 25.3, Petitioners' reply brief would be due on October 13, 2025.

This proposed briefing schedule would conclude the briefing more than ten days before the argument provided it is scheduled for November 2025 or later. If argument is scheduled for October 2025, Petitioners and Respondents jointly propose the following schedule: The time in which to file Petitioners' brief would be extended to and including July 22, 2025, and the time in which to file Respondents' brief would be extended to and including August 26, 2025. Under Rule 25.3, Petitioners' reply brief would be due on September 25, 2025.
