

MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Pursuant to Rule 39 of the Rules of the Supreme Court and 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(d)(7), Petitioner Ismail Salaam requests leave to file his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit without prepaying costs, and to proceed in forma pauperis.
