MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner Londell Bond, through undersigned counsel, moves pursuant to U.S. Sup. Ct. R. 39.1 for leave to proceed in forma pauperis in his concurrently-filed Petition for Writ of Certiorari.

Mr. Bond, who is incarcerated in Pennsylvania under a sentence of life imprisonment, is indigent—he has sought and been appointed counsel in the proceedings below in federal court. His motion to proceed in forma pauperis was granted on February 9, 2022, by the Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. That order remains in effect. A copy of that order is attached to this motion.

On May 24, 2022, the Third Circuit appointed the Federal Public Defender for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania to represent Mr. Bond. That order remains in effect. A copy of the appointment order is attached.

ORDER

Appellant, Londell Bond, having satisfied the Court that he is financially unable to obtain representation by counsel, it is

ORDERED that the Federal Community Defender Organization for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania is hereby appointed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. Section 3006A(a)(2)(B) to represent Londell Bond in the above-captioned matter. This appointment shall remain in effect until termination of this case or substitute counsel is appointed.

Counsel shall have a period of 60 days to review the record. Prior to the expiration of that 60 day period, counsel shall advise the Clerk whether additional documents are necessary. If counsel does not need additional documents, the Clerk will issue a briefing schedule immediately after the 60 day review period ends. Counsel shall file the entry of appearance form within 14 days of the date of this order.

No action will be taken on Appellant's motion to stay the appeal. Counsel may renew the motion, if counsel deems it appropriate to do so.
