Before the undersigned Justice is Ernest Edwards's untitled Motion No. 2024-1961, which is in the nature of a petition for a writ of certiorari and a request for an extension to file the petition.

On January 23, 2024, the Court of Appeals handed down its decision in *Edwards v. State*, No. 2022-KA-00719-COA. It then denied rehearing on May 14, 2024, and Edwards received notice that same day. The mandate issued on June 4, 2024.

Edwards had to and including May 28, 2024, within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. See M.R.A.P. 17(b). The motion now before the Court was not filed until June 10, 2024. It includes an affidavit that was signed and notarized on June 3, 2024, so it could not have been mailed before then. *Contra Order, Spraggins v. State*, No. 2016-CT-00357-SCT (Miss. Mar. 1, 2018) (deeming a petition for a writ of certiorari timely based on the prison-mailbox rule).

After due consideration, the undersigned Justice finds that the extension request should be denied and that the petition for a writ of certiorari should be dismissed as untimely.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion is denied in part and dismissed in part. The request for an extension is denied, and the petition for a writ of certiorari is
