MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Antonio Ulises Barrera Mackorty (“Petitioner”), through his counsel of record, Callie Glanton Steele, Esq., hereby requests that this Court permit him to proceed in forma pauperis regarding the petition for a writ of certiorari which is being filed on his behalf.

Undersigned counsel was a member of the Federal Public Defender’s Office in the Central District of California and was one of the attorneys who tried the case in June of 2022.
