MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND TO APPOINT APPELALTE COUNSEL

On this date came to be considered a Motion to Withdraw and to Appoint Appellate Counsel for defendant, Brian Dale Nixon, who was convicted of Capital Murder on July 14, 2021 and assessed a sentence of Life Without the Possibility of Parole.

The Court finds that Brian Dale Nixon has been represented by appointed counsel, the Regional Public Defenders Office, and that his financial situation has not changed since the initial appointment. The Court finds that Mr. Nixon is entitled to appointed counsel for the purposes of appeal from his conviction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Regional Public Defenders Office shall be granted leave to withdraw and discharged from further responsibilities for the representation of Brian Dale Nixon.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that attorney Michael Gross shall be appointed to represent Brian Dale Nixon on appeal to the intermediary court of appeals and any subsequent appeal to the Texas Court of Criminal Appeal, or until such appointment is terminated by this Court.
