MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Petitioner, through his appointed attorneys, Hartmann Doherty Rosa Berman & Bulbulia LLP (by Mark A. Berman, *Counsel of Record*), hereby moves before the Honorable Chief Justice and Honorable Associate Justices of the United States Supreme Court for entry of an order permitting her to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

In support of this motion, Petitioner submits that both the District Court and the Court of Appeals found that Petitioner was indigent and, thus, eligible for the appointment of counsel under the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A. Accordingly, undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Petitioner on appeal.

For these reasons, Petitioner's motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* should be granted.
