Motion to extend the time to file a brief in opposition to Petitioners' petition for a writ of certiorari

Dear Clerk of the Court:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, this letter serves as the motion of Respondents Regents of the University of Minnesota (named in the caption as "Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota"), Kendall Powell, Steven A. Sviggum, Mary A. Davenport, Kao Ly Ilean Her, Mike O. Kenyanya, Janie S. Mayeron, David J. McMillan, Darrin M. Rosha, Joan T.A. Gabel, James T. Farnsworth, Douglas A. Huebsch, Ruth E. Johnson, Kodi J. Verhalen, and Calvin D. Phillips to extend the time to file a brief in opposition to Petitioners' petition for a writ of certiorari. The brief in opposition is currently due February 18, 2025, and Respondents respectfully request an extension of fifteen days, or until March 5, 2025 (accounting for weekends and holidays, as provided in Supreme Court Rule 30.1).

Respondents request this extension in good faith. As I previously shared, the undersigned counsel is not a member of the Bar of the Supreme Court, as required to file a brief in opposition; I have submitted my application materials to the Court but I have not yet been notified of admission. A fifteen-day extension will give time to facilitate my admission without unduly extending this matter, in which there is no basis for expedited consideration. Finally, I have consulted with opposing counsel regarding the extension, and he has no objection.
