Dear Clerk of the Court:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, this letter serves as the motion of Respondents Regents of the University of Minnesota (named in the caption as "Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota"), Kendall Powell, Steven A. Sviggum, Mary A. Davenport, Kao Ly Ilean Her, Mike O. Kenyanya, Janie S. Mayeron, David J. McMillan, Darrin M. Rosha, Joan T.A. Gabel, James T. Farnsworth, Douglas A. Huebsch, Ruth E. Johnson, Kodi J. Verhalen, and Calvin D. Phillips to extend the time to file a brief in opposition to Petitioners' petition for a writ of certiorari. The brief in opposition is currently due today, and Respondents respectfully request an extension of two days, or until March 7, 2025.

Respondents request this extension in good faith. Overnight and into the morning, Minnesota experienced a substantial winter storm. Law enforcement in certain areas has asked that all non-essential travel be limited until snow can be cleared, which has hindered the ability for our printer to prepare our filing. A two-day extension will give time to clear snow and allow the safe preparation of the filing, without unduly extending this matter.
