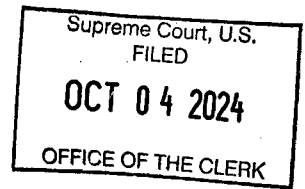

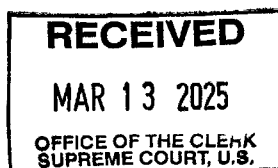

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

(Count 1) I filed a complaint against GM on March 6, 2019 (Ex. 2) and there was an order from JP13 – case No: JP13-18-003067 and a summons was issued on (3-27-18) court order – states notice issued summons was served on the defendant – of 3-27-18. Defendant did not respond as ordered by the court (JP13) as required and summons stated failure to file an answer may result in a default judgment being entered against you and Rule 55 states failure to answer or enter ~~your~~ appearance. Also be a default as required as well. See copy attached (docket sb/copy) still pending court, common pleas). This clearly error for this court (JP) – to allow GM to file answer after 15 days as order and required. GM did not answer not until 4-25-18. GM was untimely. Under Rule 60 – provides that court may relieve party from final judgment. See Del. Superior Court R60 (b)(c) for reason unjustified relief from the operation of the judgment. See case law, Pitts v. White, 48 Del. 311, 103 A2d 245 (1954). I am seeking under law for justifying relief from of judgment under JP order of summons. GM was untimely to file their answer. See docket sheet attached:
