This firm is counsel for the respondents in the above-captioned case. Petitioners filed their petition for a writ of certiorari on December 23, 2024. The case was placed on the docket on December 30, 2024. Pursuant to Rule 15.3, the due date for a brief in opposition is Wednesday, January 29, 2025.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response be extended by 30 days, to and including Friday, February 28, 2025.


