Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel of record for the respondent Hunter Warfield, Inc., in the above-captioned case. Hannah Hekel filed her petition for a writ of certiorari on March 7, 2025, and the Court docketed the petition on May 13, 2025. Respondent waived its right to file a response but the Court nevertheless requested one. The response is presently due on July 3, 2025.

Pursuant to this Court's Rule 30.4, the respondent respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time, up to and including September 2, 2025, within which to file a response. The timing of the response falls in the middle of several other significant deadlines for the undersigned, such that a shorter extension would be insufficient. Specifically, I am currently slated to start a multi-day jury trial in Florida on June 24. I will be attending and speaking at an annual conference from July 23-25. I also have two appellate briefs due. One is due on August 1 in a matter pending before the Fourth Circuit, and the other is a post-trial appellate brief due on August 7 in a matter pending before the Indiana Court of Appeals.

The extension is not sought for the purpose of delay and is necessary so that I may devote the proper attention to the response while also attending to the above matters. I have conferred with counsel of record for the petitioner, and counsel consents to the requested extension.
