DECLARATION OF TIMELY FILING PURSUANT TO RULE 29.02


I, Goodloe T. Lewis, a member of the Bar of this Court and counsel of record for Petitioner Jamarr Smith, hereby certify, pursuant to Rule 29.2, that on May 13, 2025, I timely filed Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari, appendix, motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* ("IFP"), and proof of service in this Court.

On March 31, 2025, Justice Alito extended the time for Petitioner to file a certiorari petition to May 13, 2025. No. 24A933.
