Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, the State of Louisiana respectfully requests an extension of 30 days, to and including July 30, 2025, within which to file its brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in *Lamizana v. Louisiana*, No. 24-7252. The Court docketed the petition on April 30, 2025. The State filed a response waiver on May 21, 2025. The Court requested a response on May 29, 2025. The State's brief in opposition is currently due on June 30, 2025.

This is the State's first request for an extension of time. The extension is needed in light of other deadlines and conflicts faced by undersigned counsel of record for the State, including a motion for summary judgment due (pending adoption of a joint proposed briefing schedule) on June 30 in *Louisiana v. Trump*, No. 25-cv-71 (W.D. La.); a reply brief due (pending adoption of the State's proposed briefing schedule) on July 2 in *Voice of the Experienced v. LeBlanc*, No. 25-30322 (5th Cir.); and a reply brief in support of the petition for writ of certiorari due on July 21 in *Hutson v. United States*, No. 24-1022 (U.S.).
