**INDICTMENT**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

**COUNT ONE**

On or about **November 28, 2022**, in the Southern District of Texas, and within the jurisdiction of the Court, Defendants,

**NOE DE JESUS MARTINEZ-MONTELONGO and  
FIDEL SALDANA RODRIGUEZ,**

did knowingly conspire and agree with each other and with other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jurors to import 50 grams and more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers and 500 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 963, 952(a), 960(a)(1) and (b)(1)(H).

**COUNT TWO**

On or about **November 28, 2022**, in the Southern District of Texas, and within the jurisdiction of the Court, Defendants,

**NOE DE JESUS MARTINEZ-MONTELONGO and  
FIDEL SALDANA RODRIGUEZ,**

did knowingly import into the United States of America from the United Mexican States a

controlled substance. This offense involved a quantity of 50 grams and more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers and 500 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 952(a), 960(a)(1) and (b)(1)(H), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
