MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Comes now, Petitioner, Jody D. Owens, by Phillip R. Dormeyer, Criminal Justice Act (“CJA”) Panel Attorney appointed by the Eastern District of Missouri, and requests that the Court permit Petitioner to proceed in forma pauperis with regard to this Petition for a Writ of Certiorari, which Counsel is filing contemporaneously on Petitioner’s behalf.
